What's Happening:	<i>All changes will be published on March 16, 2022.</i> Changes to the CEOS IDN, SOOS, AMD Portals - Enhanced Platform Facet Search Refinement - A more finely-grained query refinement enables users to locate the desired Platform faster resulting in more precise search results. Changes to the GCMD Keywords (KMS) Platform Keyword Hierarchy

- Added New Top Level Keyword: "Basis"
- Added 6 new Keywords at the "Basis" level:
 - **Air-based Platforms**
 - **Land-based Platform**
 - **Living Organism-based Platforms**
 - **Other**
 - **Space-based Platforms**
 - **Water-based Platforms**
- Renamed and Expanded the "Category" Level
- Renamed "Series_Entity" Level to "Sub_Category"

Action Needed:	- No Action needed for portals. - Metadata curators creating new metadata must use the new "Category" values in the UMM-C/PlatformType "Type" field (if Cmr-Validate-Keywords=True) - Support for new "Type" keywords is built in if you use MMT or dMMT to create a new collection. - Example: Platform Keyword with old value and with new value ECHO-10 - Old: <pre> <Platforms> <Platform> <ShortName>NASA DC-8</ShortName> <LongName>NASA Douglas DC-8</LongName> <Type>Aircraft</Type> <Instruments> <Instrument> <ShortName>Cameras</ShortName> </Instrument> </Instruments> </Platform> </Platforms> </pre> New: <pre> <Platforms> <Platform> <ShortName>NASA DC-8</ShortName> <LongName>NASA Douglas DC-8</LongName> <Type>Jet</Type> <Instruments> <Instrument> <ShortName>Cameras</ShortName> </Instrument> </Instruments> </Platform> </Platforms> </pre> - Metadata curators updating existing metadata where the "Category" values in the UMM-C/PlatformType "Type" field have changed can update their metadata over time as Progressive Update permits ingest of metadata with existing errors (for as long as new errors are not introduced).
