Element Description

Information about any constraints for accessing the service.

Best Practices

The Access Constraints element is optional and allows the author to provide information concerning access constraints about the service. This includes any special restrictions, legal prerequisites, and limitations and/or warnings on accessing the service.

Examples:

- Registration is required to access this service.
- None.
- User authentication is required to access this service.
